

1/8/12 THERE IS ONLY ONE SON OF GOD.

First of all, there is no good way of saying that. The vision above comes out sexist. If I say, "There is only One Child of God, we might get into problems with the "child" part. (I know. Jesus did say "become ye as little children," but the "child" piece still causes problems for some).

Ram Dass likes to remind us, "There is only One of us here."

Another of my problems is that my mind, my limited mortal mind cannot wrap itself around this concept. Duh! Well, of course it can't. The concept is too big and contradictory to everything we think about separateness. Suppose I perceive myself as sick or even hurt or angry. What I then do is to wrap my personal self around that issue or feeling and make it my own. Of course, then no matter how much work I have done on myself, I will begin to feel guilt and shame and figure I must have done something "wrong" to produce this negative thing. (I refer to this as New Age blame, shame and guilt).

What I am becoming aware of is that if there is Only One Son of God, then disease, anger, fear and all the other illusions we might be creating are being created by the One Son, not by a particular individual.

"I'm sick." No. I am suffering from the illusion of sickness that the One son of God crested out of His/Her sense of separateness.

What I choose to Dewitt my anger, fear, sickness, etc. Will either contribute to the healing the One Onset God or contribute to enhancing the illusion.

I do not understand all this because it cannot be understood by the individual mind. The individual mind by its very nature only understands separateness.
